Westminster Primary Academy is taking steps to become a Sun Safe Accredited School, this will form part of our duty of care to ensure the health and wellbeing of your child/children during school hours.

This scheme has been developed by national skin cancer charity 'Skcin', to encourage primary schools and parents/carers to work together to ensure that our children grow up with a good understanding of the importance of sun safety and that they are adequately protected against UV during school hours.

As part of our commitment to providing a sun safe environment we are asking for you to provide appropriate sun hats, however the school would like to assist with providing sun cream protection by installing around school several sun cream dispensers. With these dispensers made available, parents will not need to worry about remembering to apply sun cream in the mornings. To be able to do this we are asking parents for a contribution of £1 per family.

Sunscreen will be applied by the children before extended periods of time outdoors such as lunch breaks when UV penetration is at its peak.
